

RESIDENCE HALL ALCOHOL AND DRUG POLICY

I. POLICY STATEMENT

This policy provides rules about prohibited alcohol and drug use in University operated residence halls.

II. POLICY PRINCIPLES

- A. All Residents are expected to abide by all provisions of the [*Code of Student Conduct*](#) related to alcohol and drugs.
- B. The possession, distribution or consumption of alcohol in University operated residence halls is prohibited, regardless of age.
- C. The possession of empty alcohol containers in a residence hall room or suite or any other area of the residence hall is prohibited.
- D. The possession, distribution or use of illegal drugs in University operated residence halls is prohibited.
- E. Knowingly being in the presence of alcohol or illegal drugs, whether or not the substance is actively being used, is prohibited.
- F. Possession of drug paraphernalia, such as materials for the intended or implied use of controlled substances or paraphernalia possessing illegal drug residue, including but not limited to devices and/or materials used to prepare, manufacture, use, or conceal the use of drugs or for any drug related use, is prohibited.
