RESIDENCE HALL TRASH AND RECYCLING POLICY

I. POLICY STATEMENT

Auburn University expects all residents in University operated residence halls to remove all trash and recycling from their living space.

II. POLICY PRINCIPLES

- A. **Trash and Recycling.** Residents are responsible for removing all garbage and recycling from their living space in a timely manner. Trash and recycling may only be placed in designated containers.
- B. **Needle Disposal.** The disposal of used hypodermic needles and syringes anywhere except specifically approved "Sharps" containers is prohibited.
