

## **Undergraduate Course Repeat Policy**

No student may repeat a course for credit in which the student has previously earned a grade of A, B, or C without written permission from the student's academic dean. Courses specifically designated as repeatable in the [Auburn University Bulletin](#) are exempt from this regulation. Students may repeat courses, only once, in which they earn a grade of D or F without written permission from the student's academic dean. Grades and hours for both attempts will be included in the calculation of the GPA unless the [Grade Adjustment Policy](#) has been invoked for the first attempt. (See the previous section for limitations and procedures). If the grade adjustment policy is not invoked in the case of the repeat of a D grade, then the course credit hours may count only once toward graduation unless the course is designated as repeatable.
